Live Music

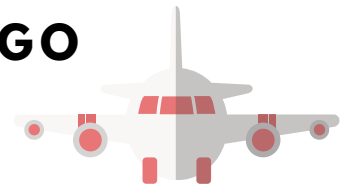
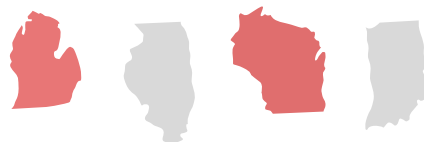
This city is in love with jazz and blues, as well as music festivals and concerts of all kinds. If you're lucky, catch a show by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra.
